

### United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space

- UN <u>permanent Committee</u>.
- Set up by the General Assembly of the UN in 1959.
- A unique platform for world-wide space cooperation.
- 92 member <u>States</u> plus about 40 Associations and Observers.
  (Singapore and Ruanda are currently candidates)

## United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space

- 2 Subsidiary Bodies: the <u>Scientific and Technical Subcommittee</u>, and the <u>Legal Subcommittee</u>, both established in 1961.
- Reports to the <u>Fourth Committee of the General Assembly</u>, which adopts an annual resolution on <u>international cooperation</u> in the peaceful uses of outer space.

## United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space

- The Committee and its subcommittees rely on the principle of consensus.
- COPUOS suggest recommendations to the United Nations General Assembly and publish <u>yearly reports</u> providing detailed information on their activities.
- The Committee was instrumental in the creation of the <u>five treaties</u> and five principles of outer space.

#### Mock Exercise




- Simulate a COPUOS session debating about the establishment of an open and global space-based UN <u>climate observing satellite system</u>.
